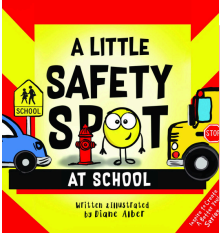

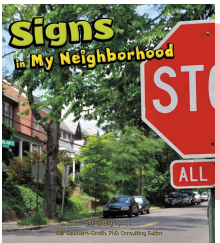

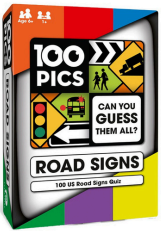
A LITTLE SPOT OF SAFETY AT SCHOOL BY DIANE ALBER

Join these adorable safety spots as they show children how to be safe both inside and outside of school. This includes bus safety, car safety, playground safety, germs, drills and much more.



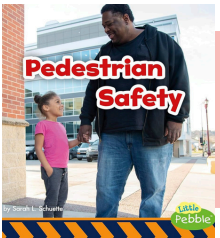
SIGNS IN MY NEIGHBORHOOD BY SHELLY LYONS

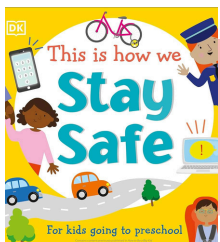
