

Student- Behavior Tracking Chart[~]

Fill out this chart any time Student has a behavior. Behaviors are defined below for consistency.

Definitions of Behavior:

Inappropriate gestures: any time Student raises her middle finger (or index finger used as middle finger), sticks out her tongue or hits her fist against her open palm.

Swearing: any time Student verbalizes a swear word.

Crying: when there is no obvious cause of distress (pain, falling, etc.) and Student begins crying. Crying in response to be corrected for her behavior.

Yelling: any time Student uses a voice louder than a typical indoor voice. This can be directed at staff or students.

Aggression: any time Student uses her hands or feet on another student or staff in an aggressive manner. Examples are hitting, kicking, pushing and pinching.
