The unique characteristics of children with autism and related disorders present challenges in potty training. The book offers a different set of strategies.



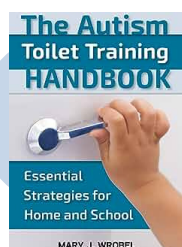
