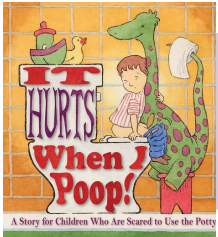

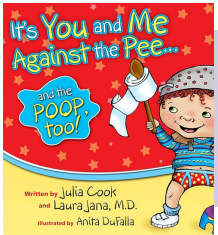

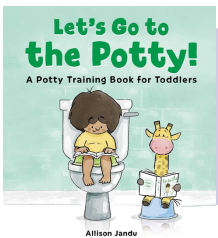

A young boy with a stomach ache visits the doctor and learns about how the body digests food and gets rid of waste, which makes him more comfortable with using the toilet.



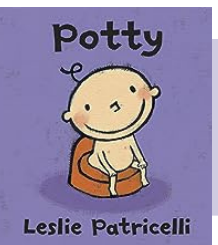
IT'S YOU AND ME AGAINST THE PEE... AND THE POOP, TOO! BY WRITTEN BY JULIA COOK
