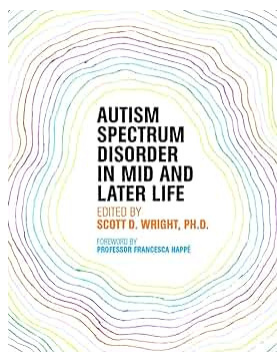
OLDER ADULTS AND AUTISM SPECTRUM CONDITIONS BY WENN LAWSON
