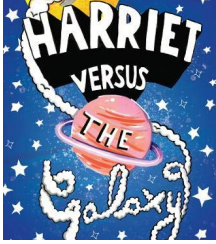

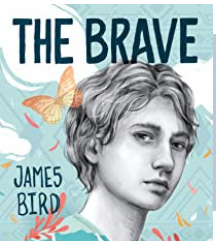

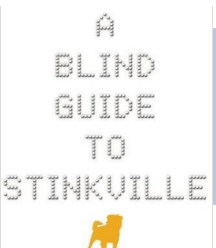
HEAR ME BY KERRY O'MALLEY CERRA
