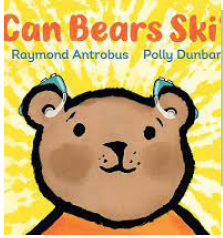

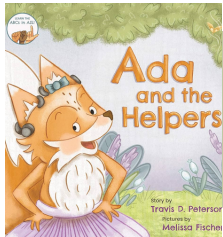
CHARACTERS WHO ARE DEAF OR HARD OF HEARING

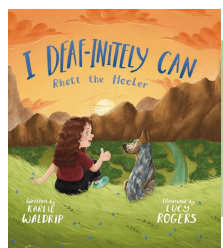
CRAZY FOR APPLES BY C.L. REID

Emma, a deaf girl, and her best friend Izzie are going to the apple orchard today in order to pick apples for cooking, but their basket of apples ends up in the mud.



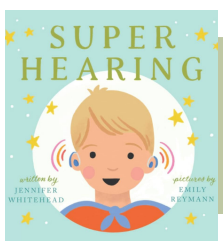
CARL ENTERS A CONTEST BY ERIN SAVORY
