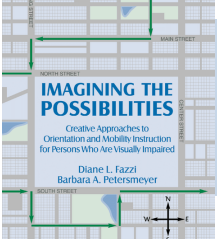


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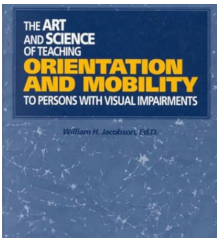

This book explores creative methods of teaching various O&M techniques to persons who are blind or visually impaired, including those with multiple disabilities.



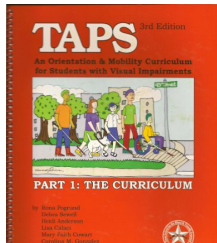

Through activities that encourage freedom of movement, children who are visually impaired can gain a better understanding of the world around them and learn to move confidently.



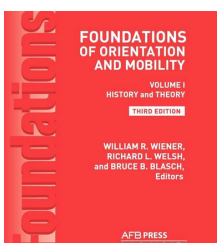
