Responsibilities:

- Provide consultative services to district staff, students, and parents to include:
- Individualized educational recommendations through onsite and distance delivery for students aged three through 21.
- Assisting with the development and implementation of student IEP/instructional programs.
- Evaluating student progress on an ongoing basis and recommending intervention strategies.
- Demonstrating/teaching specialized strategies and/or providing topical in-services and workshops to local schools, personnel, parents, students, peers, and the community.
- Assisting districts in procuring/adapting specialized instructional materials.
- Facilitating interagency collaboration and networking.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Master's degree in special education with an emphasis in autism/emotional/behavioral disorders OR a bachelor's degree in special education and suitable experience.
- Knowledge of current research and range of educational practices in the field of autism.
- Recent experience working with learners who experience autism spectrum disorders and their families.
- Experience in developing communication skills, positive behavior support plans, and visual supports.
- Experience in teaching social interaction and play skills.
- Implementation and best practice in the education of students with autism spectrum disorders.
- Ability to travel independently in rural/remote Alaska throughout the school year.
- Experience with distance education technologies, digital learning, and e-module creation.
- The requirements for an Alaska State Department of Education Special Education Type A Certificate or a Special Services Type C Certificate have been met.
